II. MAJOR REQUIREMENTS.....74
2.0 major GPA is required for graduation. Major GPA calculation will include all courses taken in the major department, plus any other courses under II. Minimum of 18 semester hours of courses taken to fulfill major requirements must be courses offered by Appalachian.

The Bachelor of Science in Social Work (B.S.W.) degree consists of 74 semester hours to include the following: Forty-five (45) semester hours of professional core courses in social work, including field work placements and social work electives; twenty-nine (29) semester hours of related cognate courses in several departments and disciplines. Math 1010 should be taken to fulfill the Mathematics requirement of the core curriculum.
